

Accounting Word Search

This activity may be used to review accounting terms and concepts.

Corresponding Events:

Accounting I, Accounting II

Objectives:

- Identify accounting vocabulary
- Identify accounting concepts

Materials:

- Activity sheet (please see attached)

Activity Time:

Twenty minutes

Concepts Taught:

- Accounting vocabulary

How to Play:

1. Distribute Accounting Word Search sheet giving directions.
2. Students complete the activity sheet individually within the time limit set by the teacher.
3. Teacher may give answers. Students may correct their own or exchange papers. Teacher may choose to collect papers for individual grading.

Options:

This activity may be used as a class warm-up activity and/or a class review activity.

Assessments:

As the activity progresses, move around the room to monitor students. Students may be given points for completing this activity.
