Materials

- 25-30 Lunch bags
- markers/colored pencils
- props or clues

How to Play

1. The students color the bags in any acceptable way they choose.
 2. Inside each bag place 3-4 clues to a "mystery." If props like a toy gun, broken mirror, note, etc., can be used; then the props are put in the bag instead/with clues.
 3. The students use the clues to write a story on what they believed happened. The teacher can check the students' creativity, spelling/grammar/writing skills for the term. The students have fun, and the teacher has a great assessment tool.
